

Elizabeth, da. of Rev. Edward March Philipps, Rector of Hathern, co. Leicester, Chancellor of the Diocese of Gloucester, and niece of Charles March Philipps of Garendon Park, co. Leicester, Esq.; born 7 March 1814; married at Hathern 9 September 1845; died at Hathern 19 June 1866. 1st wife.

Edward Smythies (20) of Hathern, co. Leicester, born at Clare Park, Crondal, Hants, 21 June 1818 and baptized at Eardisland Church, co. Hereford, 22 July 1821; educated at Rugby School; A.B. 1842, Emmanuel College, Cambridge; Rector of Hathern, co. Leicester, 1859, and Rural Dean; died at Hathern Rectory 7 Oct. 1891 and is buried in the churchyard there. Mural monument.

Georgiana, da. of Samuel Bucknill, F.R.C.S., of Rugby; married April 1868. 2nd wife.

Edward Henry Philipps Smythies (21), born at Newbold-on-Avon 25 August 1846 and baptized there 4 October 1846; died in infancy and buried at Hathern 6 December 1851.

Arthur Smythies (22) of Hilliers, Dolton, co. Devon, born at Newbold-on-Avon 16 December 1847 and baptized there 25 January 1848; educated at Rugby School; A.B. 1870 Trinity College, Cambridge; served in the Woods and Forests' Department, India, from 1873 to 1892, when he retired as Conservator of Forests (2nd Grade).

Gertrude Frances Morse, da. of Col. Henry Aston, Bombay Army (retired); married at St. Thomas's Church, Saharanpur, India, 28 June 1884.

Evelyn Arthur Smythies (23), b. at Dehra Dun, India, 19 March 1885 and bapt. at Landour 26 Sept. 1885; educated at Cheltenham College; entered, Oct. 1904, Christ's College, Cambridge; transferred, Oct. 1905, to Balliol College, Oxford, A.B. 1907 (1st Cl. Nat. Sc.); passed 2nd into the Woods and Forests' Department, India; appointed Assistant Conservator of Forests November 1908.

Olive Muriel, da. of Percy Rowland Cripps of Winford Manor, co. Somerset, Esq., J.P.; mar. at St. John's Church, Lucknow, India, 3 April 1911.

Bernard Edward Smythies (24), born at Dehra Dun, India, 9 Dec. 1886 and baptized at St. Thomas's Church, Dehra Dun, 18 Feb. 1887; educated at Cheltenham College, from which he passed into the Royal Military Academy, Woolwich; gazetted 2nd Lieut. in the Royal Engineers 1905, and promoted Lieut. 13 Feb. 1908.

Frances Enid (25), born at Masuri, India, 22 June 1889 and baptized at Christ Church, Masuri, in Sep. following.

Katherine Margaret Gouldsmith, of Shanklin, I. of Man on May 18th 1916.

Bertram Evelyn Smythies, born Nami Tal, India, July 11th 1912.
