Page 51. To the note regarding Charles Norfolk Smythies (B 63), add:—Dr. Smythies matriculated at Trinity College, Oxford, on the 5th December, 1831, his age at the time being recorded in "Alumni Oxoniensis" as 19. (The date of his birth was entered inadvertently in the pedigree as 1814 instead of 1812.) In 1832 he became a student at Lincoln's Inn; he took his degree as B.C.L. in 1838, and D.C.L. in 1842.
